

belonging to The Union Pacific Railway Company, a corporation formed by articles of union and consolidation between The Union Pacific Railroad Company, the Kansas Pacific Railway Company and the Denver Pacific Railway and Telegraph Company, which articles of union and consolidation bear date January 24th, 1889, and were filed in the Department of the Interior of the United States at Washington in the District of Columbia on or about January 24th, 1890, or any or either of its said constituent companies, including all the rights and titles to said lands or any of them that heretofore were vested in any of said companies, together with the right to acquire patents from the United States for the said lands and all other rights under the Acts of Congress granting such lands to any of said companies, also all the land contracts, bills receivable and proceeds arising from the sale or other disposition of said lands, or any of them, now or hereafter outstanding and existing for or with respect to the disposal of any of said lands by all of said companies, or any of them. And whereas, the lands, land grants, land rights and other property, hereinafter more particularly described, were sold on or about the 19th day of February, 1895, under certain decrees of foreclosure entered in certain causes pending in the United States Circuit Courts, for the District of Kansas, the Western District of Missouri and the District of Colorado, in which said causes Russell Sage and George F. Gould, Trustees, were complainants and The Union Pacific Railway Company and others were defendants, which causes were instituted for the foreclosure of the Consolidated First Mortgage of the Kansas Pacific Railway Company, dated May 15th, 1877, to Alvin W. Kreh and Laurence Greer, who, having paid the purchase price by their bid for such lands, land grants, land rights and other property, assigned their bids therefor, and the right to receive a deed conveying the same, to the Land Company and caused conveyances of such lands, land grants, land rights and other property to be executed to the Land Company for and in consideration, among other
