aforesaid of any Trustee under this Deed of Trust, all
his powers and authority shall cease, and on appointment
and confirmation as aforesaid, or appointment by such
court, of his successor, shall vest in such successor. During
any vacancy so caused the two remaining Trustees shall
be vested with all the powers and authority conferred by this
instrument. Eighth- The said Arthur P. Luke, George
A. Nickerson, and Josiah D. Bennett hereby accept the
trust conferred upon them by these presents upon the terms
and conditions hereinbefore set forth, and agree to perform
the covenants and agreements in their behalf hereinbefore
contained. In witness whereof the said The Southern
Kansas Railway Company has caused its corporate
seal to be hereto attached and these presents to be signed
by its President and attested by its Secretary, and the said
Arthur P. Luke, George A. Nickerson and Josiah D. Bennett
have respectively set their hands and seals on this
