This Indenture made this 24th day of September, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety eight between Robert R. Clark and Mary R. Clark, husband and wife, of Lawrence, in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and Annie E. Warner of the second part: Witnesseth. That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred (\$1500⁰⁰) Dollars, to them duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit: Park Lots Nos. Four (4) and Six (6) in the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said part of the first part therein. And the said Robert R. Clark, does hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof he is the lawful owner of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance, therein, free, and clear of all incumbrances, and that he will warrant and defend the same against all claims whatsoever. This Grant is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars, according to the terms of one certain promissory note this day executed by the said Robert R. Clark and Mary R. Clark, to the said party of the second part, said note being given for the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars, dated Sept. 24th 1898 due and payable in three years from date thereof with interest thereon from the date thereof, until paid according to the terms of said note and coupons thereto attached.
