

removed, and shall duly assign, transfer and deliver to such new Trustee any stocks bonds and moneys held hereunder for the further security of the bondholders. The old Trustee shall, thereupon, be discharged from further liability hereunder.

It is understood and agreed that the word "Trustee", as used in this instrument shall be held and construed to mean the party of the second part or its successor or successors for the time being in the ^{trust} hereby created.

Article Seventeen. The Trustee, party of the second part hereto, hereby accepts the trusts in this indenture declared and provided.

Article Eighteen. Whereas, in order to expedite the recording of this indenture ten uniform originals thereof have been simultaneously executed, acknowledged and delivered by the Railway Company and by the Trustee, now this indenture further witnesses that each of said instruments so executed, acknowledged and delivered is and shall be deemed to be an original, and that all together shall constitute but one and the same instrument. In Witness whereof, the party of the first part has caused these presents to be signed by its President, and its corporate seal to be hereto affixed and attested by the secretary, and the party of the second part has caused these presents to be signed by its President, and its corporate seal to be hereto affixed and attested by its Secretary. the day and year first above written.
