 Coupons to be attached to said bonds shall be authenticated by the engraved signature of the
 Treasurer of the Railway Company, who shall be in office at the time of the execution of this
 Mortgage, or, at the option of the Railway Company, of any future Treasurer, it being the
 intention that the Railway Company may adopt and use for that purpose the engraved signature
 of its Treasurer at the date of the execution of this Mortgage, although he may have ceased to
 be its Treasurer when the bonds are actually certified and delivered; And whereas, the
 Railway Company has duly resolved to secure equally and ratably the payment of the principal
 and interest of all of said bonds, issued and to be issued, by a Mortgage or deed of trust
 of the properties and franchises of the Railway Company, and this indenture having been
 submitted to the Board of Directors of the Railway Company, it has been duly
 resolved that the same be executed by the President of the Railway Company on
 its behalf, that the corporate seal of the Railway Company be hereunto affixed
 and attested by its Secretary, and that this indenture be delivered on behalf
 of the Railway Company to the trustee herein named, and that the same be
 duly recorded: Now, Therefore, this Indenture Witnesseth: That the said
 The Kansas City, Lawrence & Topeka Railway Company, in consideration
 of the premises and of the sum of one dollar to it in hand paid by said
 Trustee, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and of the
 acceptance by said trustee of the trust hereby created, in order to
 secure the due and punctual payment of the principal and interest on
 its said bonds, and the punctual performance of all the covenants and
 agreements on its part herein contained, has granted, bargain, sold,
 assigned, set over, released, conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents
 does grant, bargain, sell, assign, set over, release, convey and confirm
 unto the said Colonial Trust Company, as Trustee as aforesaid, and to
 its successors and assigns, the following property of said Railway Company to-wit:
 All the right, title and interest of the said party of the first part in and to the line of railroad
 of said party of the first part, in the Counties of Wyandotte, Leavenworth, Douglas, Shawnee,
 and Osage, in the State of Kansas, constructed, or to be constructed, commencing at the
 terminus of the Kansas City Elevated Railway Company at 18th street in Grandview;
 thence in a westerly and northwesterly direction to the north line of the right of way
 of the Union Pacific Railway Company; also beginning at 17th and Osage Street
 in Kansas City, Kansas, (Unionville) thence west on Osage Street to the western
 limits of Kansas City, Kansas; thence in a westerly or northwesterly direction
 to a junction with the line first above described at the north line of the right
 of way of the Union Pacific Railway Company; thence alongside of the right
 of way of the Union Pacific Railway Company and north thereof through Wyandotte
 and Leavenworth Counties to a point at or near the town of Pinewood in Leavenworth
 County; thence across the Kansas River into Douglas County, and thence west to
 the west line of Douglas County through the City of Lawrence and the
