The Missouri and Kansas Telephone Company also possesses the right to use certain inventions patents and telephone instruments under licenses from The American Bell Telephone Company and particularly owns and holds from the same company under divers contracts and agreements found in the forms known and designated by The American Bell Telephone Company as Contract for exchanges Form 109 D. Contract for Extra Territorial Connecting Lines Form 113 D and Contract for Private Lines and other purposes Form 116 D. dated the 4th day of January 1883 conveying the right to use the patents and telephone instruments of The American Bell Telephone Company and thereunder and by means thereof to conduct and carry on telephone exchange toll line and private business in all the counties of the State of Kansas and in all of the State of Missouri except the counties of Ballinger Butler Crawford Cape Girardeau Carter Dunklin Dent Franklin Howell Iron Jefferson Lincoln Mississippi Maries Miller Madison New Madrid Oregon Pulaski Phelps Perry Penniscot Ripley Reynolds Scott Stoddard St. Charles St. Louis St. Francis St. Genevieve Shannon Texas Warren Washington Wayne and except the City of Saint Louis. The licenses above mentioned are expressed to be assignable only with the consent of The American Bell Telephone Company and the latter company has given its consent to the assignment made by these presents and in an agreement between The American Bell Telephone Company and The Missouri and Kansas Telephone Company and the Old Colony Trust Company dated the 2nd of October 1899 it is further provided that the said licenses shall pass to the Trustee of these presents or its assigns in case the mortgage premises described in these presents shall be sold under the provisions
