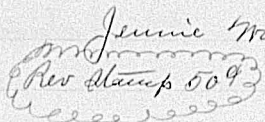

Means of Lawrence of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas do hereby grant, bargain, sell assign and set over to H. Paulus Trustee of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, a certain indenture of Mortgage executed by L. J.
