And, whereas, the Trustee has required the execution of this indenture for the purpose of expressly and specifically subjecting to the lien of said General Mortgage the said railroads, telegraph lines, estates, properties, rights, franchises and privileges sold and conveyed to the Railway Company, as aforesaid, and for the purpose of better effectuating and carrying out the provisions, objects and purposes of said General Mortgage and for securing the payment of the principal and interest of the bonds thereby secured; Now, therefore, this indenture, witnesseth: That in consideration of the premises, and for the purpose of carrying out and complying with the covenants and provisions of said General Mortgage, the Railway Company hereby declares to be subject to the lien and operation of said General Mortgage, and grants and confirms unto the Trustee, party of the second part, its successors and assigns, all the estate, right, title, interest and property of the Railway Company in and to all the railroads and telegraph lines, with the rights, privileges and franchises pertaining thereto, and all locomotives, engines, cars and other rolling stock wherever situated, acquired by the Railway Company since the date of the execution of said General Mortgage, including all the railroads and telegraph lines, with the rights, privilege, franchises and immunities pertaining thereto, and all locomotives, engines, cars and other rolling stock that were conveyed to the Railway Company by the deeds mentioned in the foregoing recitals hereof, that is to say: 1.
