

The Missouri and Kansas Telephone Company and the Old Colony Trust Company to  
 James A. Parker, Supplement to Mortgage dated 2<sup>nd</sup> October 1899. This indenture  
 made the 2<sup>d</sup> day of October in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-nine between  
 The Missouri and Kansas Telephone Company incorporated under the laws of the State  
 of Missouri (hereinafter called the Telephone Company) of the first part the Old Colony  
 Trust Company incorporated under the laws of the State of Massachusetts of the  
 second part and James A. Parker of Boston Massachusetts of the third part. And  
 Supplemental to a certain indenture (hereinafter called the principal indenture), dated  
 at the commencement thereof the 2<sup>d</sup> of October 1899 and made between the Telephone  
 Company and the said Old Colony Trust Company, whereas by the principal inden-  
 ture certain real and personal property were expressed to be thereby granted and con-  
 veyed by the Telephone Company to the said Old Colony Trust Company in trust to secure  
 payment of certain bonds of the Telephone Company for the aggregate sum of  
 \$1,250,000 (one million two hundred and fifty thousand dollars) in the manner  
 therein contained. And whereas none of the said \$1,250,000 bonds has been executed  
 or issued, and it has been agreed by the parties that Charles J. Hubbard  
 an individual citizen of the State of Missouri shall be appointed a trustee of the  
 principal indenture jointly with the Old Colony Trust Company and that the trust  
 premises shall be vested in them jointly upon the trusts and with and subject to  
 the powers and provisions contained therein and in a certain indenture bearing  
 even date herewith and expressed to be made between the said James A. Parker  
 of the one part and the said Old Colony Trust Company and the said Charles J.  
 Hubbard of the other part which has been prepared for that purpose and is intended  
 to be executed immediately after these presents. Now this indenture witnesseth that  
 in consideration of the premises the Telephone Company hereby grants and conveys  
 and the said Old Colony Trust Company hereby confirms unto the said James A. Parker  
 and his heirs and assigns all and singular the said real and personal property  
 in the principal indenture mentioned and expressed to be thereby granted and  
 conveyed. To have and to hold the said premises unto and to the use of the said  
 James A. Parker and his heirs and assigns for the purpose of securing the payment of the  
 said bonds in the manner and subject to the provisions contained in the principal indenture  
 and in trust immediately after the execution of these presents to grant and convey the  
 trust premises so vested in him for that purpose unto and to the use of the said Old  
 Colony Trust Company and Charles J. Hubbard and their respective successors heirs  
 and assigns in the manner expressed in the said indenture bearing even date  
 herewith and intended to be executed as aforesaid. In witness whereof the said  
 Missouri and Kansas Telephone Company and the said Old Colony Trust Company  
 have hereto set their respective common seals and caused these presents to be signed  
 in their behalf by their officers thereto duly authorized the day and year first  
 above written.
