

shall distribute the same when so converted into money (after setting apart to said party of the first part all property recovered that may be exempt by statute, and after payment of the costs, charges, disbursements and expenses incident to the assignment) among the several creditors in pro rata proportion, without preference, said assignee to be governed in all respects by the statute in force in the State of Kansas for the regulation and enforcement of assignments for the benefit of creditors. And the party of the first part does hereby make, constitute and appoint the said John C. Watts, assignee, to be his true and lawful attorney with full power of substitution to do and perform all acts for the said party of the first part, pertaining to the sale and transfer of property giving deeds and acquittances therefor, and doth hereby empower said assignee to recover all property or rights or equities in property which are not reached or recovered by any of the creditors of said party of the first part.
