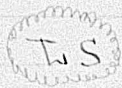

Date. This indenture, made and executed this twenty eighth day of August A.D. nineteen hundred by and between Thomas E. Evans, unmarried, of the county of Douglas and State of Kansas, party of the first part, and The Union Central Life Insurance Company, of Cincinnati, State of Ohio, party of the second part: Witnesseth, that the said first party for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred (\$1500.) Dollars, paid by the said second party, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, mortgage and warrant unto the said second party, its successors and assigns, for the certain tract or parcel of real estate, situated in the county of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: The north west quarter (4) and the north one (1) acre of the south west quarter (4) of section twenty three (23) township thirteen (13) Range nineteen (19) East of the sixth Principal Meridian, containing one hundred and sixty-one (61) acres according to Government Survey. To secure the payment of a debt evidenced by certain promissory notes of even date herewith signed by Thomas E. Evans of said first party, and payable to the said second party, more fully described, as follows: One principal note for the sum of fifteen hundred dollars, (and being for the principal sum loaned), payable two years after date (or in partial payments prior to maturity, in accordance with the stipulations therein) with interest at the rate therein specified and Covenants evidenced by coupon notes. The said first party hereby covenant and agree
