This Indenture, Made this Thirteenth day of September in the year of our Lord Nineteen Hundred, between W. S. Wood and Laura M. Wood (wife) of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Cornelia H. Curtis of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Forty Six hundred and fifty Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and Mortgage to the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns, forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: Part of Lot One-1 in Section No. Thirty-one-31-Township No. Twelve-12-South, of Range No. Twenty-20-East of the Sixth P. M. in Douglas County, State of Kansas and described as follows:

Commencing at a point three hundred and fifty-350-feet East and Forty-40-feet North of the center of Pennsylvania and Bersley Streets in the City of Lawrence, thence running East to the line of the right of way of the St Louis, Lawrence and Denver Railway Company, thence North westerly with the line of said right of way to a point due North of the place of beginning, thence South to the place of beginning.

Excepting however from said tract of land the following described piece or parcel of land, to-wit: Beginning One hundred and seventy seven-177-feet East of the North-west corner of Lot No. Forty-one-41-on Delaware Street in the City of Lawrence, thence running North Thirty-five-35-feet, thence East Forty nine-49-feet, thence South-easterly to a point Ninety three-93-feet due East of the place of beginning, thence West Ninety-three-93-feet to the place of beginning, being the piece of land conveyed to Anna Rothman by deed dated June 5th, 1873
