This Indenture, made this First day of November in the year
 of our Lord one thousand nine hundred between James E.
 Louk & Mary E. Louk his wife & Thaddeus O. Richardson
 & Addie J. Richardson his wife, of Still P.O. in the
 County of Douglas & State of Kansas, of the first part &
 Albert Hollingsworth, Guardian of Ada Hollingsworth,
 mine of the second part:

Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part in
 consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars, to them
 duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have
 sold & by these presents do grant, bargain, sell & mort-
 gage to the said party of the second part his heirs &
 assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in
 the County of Douglas & State of Kansas, described as
 follows, to-wit: Beginning at the North-west corner
 of the North-east quarter of Section number Thirty-one
 (31) in Township number twelve (12) South of Range
 number Eighteen (18) East of the sixth Principal Meridian.
 Thence running south, sixteen (16) rods, thence east seven
 (7) rods & six (6) feet, thence north sixteen (16) rods,
 thence west seven (7) rods & six (6) feet to place of
 beginning. Owner James E. Louk. And also One
 acre more or less in north-east quarter of Section
 Thirty-one (31) Township Twelve (12) Range Eighteen (18)
 beginning sixteen (16) rods south from north-west corner
 of said quarter, thence east, seventeen (17) rods & six (6)
 feet, thence south nine (9) rods, thence west seventeen (17)
 rods & six (6) feet, thence north nine (9) rods to beginning.
