Brownlee have requested the said Insurance Company to extend the time of payment of the said principal sum of nineteen hundred (1900) dollars remaining unpaid on the said bond until the first day of April 1906, and the said Insurance Company has consented and agreed to make such extension as requested; and to reduce the rate of interest to five (5) per centum per annum. Now therefore, in consideration of the premises, and of One Dollar to them in hand paid by The Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance Company, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged, the said Sallie A. Brownlee and Martin B. Brownlee hereby agree to and with The Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance Company, to pay interest on said sum of nineteen hundred (1900) dollars from the first day of April A.D. 1901, until paid, at the rate of five (5) per centum per annum, payable semi-annually on the first day of April and of October in each and every year, and to pay the said principal sum of nineteen hundred (1900) dollars on the first (1st) day of April A.D. nineteen hundred and six (1906) both principal and interest payable at the office of the said Insurance Company in the City of Milwaukee in the State of Wisconsin; and it is understood and agreed that this extension agreement shall in no manner change, affect nor modify the terms and provisions of said bond and mortgage, except as herein expressly provided.
