

This Indenture, Made this 5th day of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety nine, between E. M. Freeman and Minnie H. Freeman his wife of Marianne I. P. in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part, and The Lawrence National Bank of Lawrence Kansas of the second part,

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, ha ve sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part successors heirs and assigns forever, all the tractor parcels of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit The south half of section forty three (23) and North half of the north west quarter of section forty six (26) all in Township Fourteen (14) south of Range section (17) East of the 1st P.M. containing 400 acres more or less.

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said party of the first part therein. And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owner of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances, and that they will warrant and defend the same against all claims whatsoever, subject to a prior mortgage of \$800 to the Shawnee Fire Insurance Co. of Kansas.

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Seven hundred dollars due and payable in six months from date thereof with interest thereon from date at a per cent per annum, one certain promissory note this day executed and delivered by the said E. M. and Minnie H. Freeman to the said party of the second part; and this conveyance shall be void of such payment by said note and and if the instrument specified. And the said parties of the first part hereby agree to pay all taxes and assessments levied and assessed against said premises for their costs and expenses, and shall agree thereon in respect of said party of the second part, for such taxes and any penalties and costs which may have accrued thereon at the expense of said first party, and such taxes and penalties, costs, shall from the date of payment be any additional sum under this mortgage, or such sum as the parties shall agree to make as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or of the taxes, if the payment is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part to exercise authority to sell the same, or any part thereof, or any interest therein, or any moneys arising from the sale, or any other action to recover the same, or any interest therein, or any moneys arising from such sale, to retain the amount then due, together with the costs and charges for making such sale, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale on demand to the said E. M. Freeman his heirs and assigns.
