

This Indenture, Made this Sixth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety nine between Lida Michael and John St. Michael her husband of Willow Springs in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part, and M. Willmann of the second part,

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party

of the second part her heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at intersection of hedge fence with the south line of section sixteen (16) Township four (4) Range thirteen (13) at the distance of 10.300 chains east of the south west corner of said section sixteen (16) and running thence east on said south line of said section 120 rods to middle of said section line, thence north on middle of section line 80 rods, thence east 120 rods to the corner stone in the hedge fence set 70 chains south and 70 chains east of the northeast corner of the west half (1/2) of the south west quarter (1/4) of the south west quarter (1/4) of said section and running thence south parallel to the west line of said section 16.800 rods to beginning of section 10 acres more or less, also the west half (1/2) of the south west quarter of the south west quarter of section 17, Township four (4) Range thirteen (13) containing with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said

Lida Michael and John St. Michael do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owner of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Eight hundred dollars (\$800.)

according to the terms of One certain Mortgage note this day executed and delivered by the said Parties of the first part to the said party of the second part: Payable five years after date with interest in meantime according to contract attached to said note and with privilege of paying \$100 on account of principal money at time of paying interest and after three years. and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall be due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part her executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the party of the second part executors, administrators or assigns; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest together with the costs and charges for making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale on demand to the said Parties of the first part their heirs and assigns.
