

This Indenture, Made this Sixth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety nine, between Lida Michael and John V. Michael her husband of Willow Springs Sp. in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part, and Betty Eberhardt of the second part,

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Five hundred DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt

of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wth Beginning at intersection of hedge fence with the south line of section sixteenth Township Fourteen Range Nineteen, at the distance of 10.50 chains east of the southwest corner of said section sixteen, and running thence east on the said south line of said section 10 rods to middle of said section line, thence north on middle of section line 80 rods, thence west 152 rods to the corner stone in the hedge fence set $\frac{1}{2}$ chains south and $\frac{1}{2}$ chains east of the northeast corner of the west one half of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of said section and running thence south parallel to the west line of said section sixteen 10.50 rods to beginning containing acre upon which is the northeast half of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of the south east of $\frac{1}{2}$ chains Township Fourteen Range Nineteen containing five acres more or less, with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said part of the first part therein. do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances ~~said except as~~ ~~mortgage for \$500 of even date here with to W. Williamson~~

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars

according to the terms of Two certain Promissory Notes this day executed and delivered by the said Parties of the first part to the said party of the second part: Payable as follows \$100⁰⁰ in four years & \$400⁰⁰ in five years after date with interest at 5% from date semi-annually.

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part her executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisalment hereby waived or not at the option of the party of the second part her executors, administrators or assigns; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges for making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party of the second part to the said Parties of the first part, their heirs and assigns.
