Also any and all locomotives, engines, cars and other rolling stock, now owned, or hereafter acquired, by the Railway Company, wheresoever situated. Also any and all rights, privileges, franchises and immunities which the Railway Company now has, or shall hereafter acquire, have or possess in, to or in respect of the railroad above described or any such other lines of railway, extensions or branches, or other property, now owned or hereafter acquired, or pertaining to the use or operation or enjoyment thereof. Together with the rents, issues, profits, tolls and other benefits and advantages of, or in any way growing out of, all or any of the said railways, property and franchises, now owned or hereafter acquired. Subject, however, as to such of the above described property as is now owned by the Railway Company to the following mortgages, executed by the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railroad Company, viz.: A mortgage dated July 1, 1869, securing outstanding First Mortgage Bonds of said Railroad Company to the amount of \$7,041,000, all of which are owned by the Railway Company and pledged hereunder. A mortgage dated November 1, 1888, securing outstanding Guarantee Fund Notes of said Railroad Company to the amount of \$5,000,000, of which \$1,000,000 are owned by the Railway Company and pledged hereunder. Also all the right, title and interest which the Railway Company now has, or may hereafter acquire, in and to the following shares of the capital stock of the below mentioned railroad companies; that is to say:
