

A meeting of the congregation of the North Lawrence Christian Church of Douglas County, Kansas, having been called for the purpose of considering the question of securing a loan from the Board of Church Extension of American Christian Missionary Society for the purpose of completing a church building for said congregation, and the matter being laid before the congregation and a vote being taken on the question of borrowing the sum of \$500 from said Board for said purpose, the proposition was carried, a majority of said congregation voting in favor thereof, and the Trustees of the property of said congregation were directed to borrow said sum of \$500 from the said Board of Church Extension on the real estate of the church and the improvements thereon and execute the necessary papers therefor. This indenture, made this second day of October, 1899, by and between as Trustees of the North Lawrence Christian Church of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and American Christian Missionary Society of the second part. Witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Two dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and of the debt hereinafter mentioned, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the county of Douglas and State of Kansas to wit: Beginning at the southeast corner of Block numbered six (6) in that part of the City of Lawrence known as North Lawrence, thence west on the north line of Elm Street one hundred (100) feet, thence north one hundred feet (100); thence east one hundred (100) feet to Main Street, thence south on the west line of Main Street one hundred (100) feet to the point of beginning. And said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are as such Trustees the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances, and that they will warrant and defend the same in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns forever, against all persons claiming the same. To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the rights, privileges, tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto in anywise appertaining forever, upon the express condition to wit: That whereas said parties of the first part have this day executed and delivered their certain promissory notes to said party of the second part, payable to the order of the said second party in Kansas City, Missouri, bearing interest from date at the rate of four per cent, payable semi-annually, per annum, viz: Five principal notes for the sum of one hundred dollars each payable successively on the 12, 24, 36, 48 and 60 months after date. Now if said parties of the first part, their successors or assigns, shall pay or cause to be paid to said party of the second part, its successors or assigns, said sum of money in the above described notes mentioned, together with the interest thereon,
