

five (5) per centum per annum from the 18th day of October 1899; Now therefore, in consideration of the premises, and of one dollar to him in hand paid by The Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance Company, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged, the said William Hughes hereby agrees to and with The Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance Company, to pay interest on said sum of Five thousand (5000) dollars from the first day of October 1899 to the eighteenth day of October 1899 at the rate of six (6) per centum per annum, and to pay interest on the said sum of five thousand (5000) dollars from the eighteenth day of October 1899, until paid, at the rate of five (5) per centum per annum, payable semi-annually on the first day of April and of October in each and every year, and to pay the said balance of five thousand (5000) dollars remaining unpaid on the principal of said bond, on the eighteenth (18th) day of October A.D. nineteen hundred and four (1904), with the privilege of paying one hundred (100) dollars or more of the said principal sum on any interest paying day after October 18th 1901 and before maturity, both principal and interest payable at the office of the said Insurance Company in the City of Milwaukee, in the State of Wisconsin, and it is understood and agreed that this extension agreement shall in no manner change, affect or modify the terms and provisions of said bond and mortgage, first above mentioned, except as herein expressly provided. And the said Wesley H. Duncan, above named, in consideration of the premises hereby consents to the execution of this agreement by the said William Hughes and wife, and to the extension of the time of payment of the said sum of five thousand (5000) dollars as above stated, and also hereby covenants and agrees with said Insurance Company that the said mortgage held by him shall be and remain subject and subordinate to the said mortgage, first above mentioned, and said extension shall not in any manner affect or impair the lien of said mortgage, first above mentioned, or the right of said Insurance Company to enforce the same as security for the payment of the principal sum remaining unpaid on said bond and mortgage, first above mentioned, with interest thereon until fully paid as in said bond and mortgage, first above mentioned, and this agreement provided.
