

Whereas on April 26, 1872 Selow C. Thacher and Sarah G. his wife executed a mortgage for \$6000 on $\frac{1}{2}$ of S. W. 1/4 and S. W. 1/4 of S. W. 1/4 Sec. 15 Tp. 13 Rg. 19 in Douglas County Kansas and on other lands which mortgage was recorded May 3, 1872 in Book 25 of Mortgages at pages 481-481-482 records of said county, and whereas said mortgage was assigned by the Lombard Investment Company the mortgage therein named to the Keene First Cent Savings Bank of Keene N.H. May 11, 1877 which assignment was recorded in Book 26 p 326 of Mortgages Oct. 25, 1873. Now by request of the owner of said property and in consideration of the sum of \$4⁰⁰ the said The Keene First Cent Savings Bank do hereby release from the operation of said mortgage all of the northeast quarter of the south west quarter of said sec. 15 and all of the south west quarter of said south west quarter of said sec. 15 in Tp. 13 Rg. 19 lying south and east of the public highway running in a northeasterly and southwesterly direction through said quarter section remaining in full force on the other land covered by said mortgage, all being situated in Douglas County Kansas, said released land being 36 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres more or less.
