

This instrument, made this 8th day of November 1894 between, Joseph Lewis as Administrator of the goods, Chattle and credits of Eliza Lewis, deceased, of the City of Ithaca, County of Tompkins and State of New York of the first part, and Maria C. Lewis of the said City of Ithaca, County and State, aforesaid, of the second part, witnesses, that the party of the first part, for a good and valuable consideration to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part, has sold, assigned, transferred and conveyed, and does hereby sell, assign, transfer and convey, to the party of the second part, a certain Mortgage, bearing date the 31st day of December 1888, made by Robert A. Stute and Isabella C. his wife of Lawrence, Kansas, to Eliza Lewis, to secure the payment of the sum of Two Thousand Dollars and interest thereon from the date thereof and which said mortgage was recorded in the Clerk's office of Douglas County, State of Kansas in Book 21 of Mortgages at page 57 on the 31st day of December 1888, at 2nd o'clock P.M. together with the promissory note accompanying said Mortgage, and therein referred to, and all sums of money due and to grow due thereon. And the party of the first part hereby covenants that there is due on said promissory note and mortgage the sum of Two Thousand Dollars with interest thereon from the 31st day of December, 1893.
