

Executors Letters.

The State of Ohio }
 Lorain County, ss. } I, E. H. Hinman, Judge of the Probate Court, within and for said
 Lorain County, in the name and by the authority of the State of Ohio, do by these
 presents make known, that in Probate Court at Elyria, on the 5th day of December, one
 thousand eight hundred and ninety nine, the last will and testament of E. H.
 Metcalf late of Elyria in said county, deceased, (a copy of which is hereto annexed) was
 duly proved and allowed by said court, and that the administration of all and
 singular the goods, chattels, rights and credits of the said deceased any way
 concerning his last Will and Testament was committed to Irving W. Metcalf,
 Wilbur V. Metcalf and Maynard W. Metcalf the Executors in the said will and
 Testament named, and the said Executors shall First. Make and return to the
 Court, on oath, within three months, a true inventory of all the money, goods, chattels,
 rights and credits of the Testator which are by law to be administered, and which
 shall have come to their possession or knowledge, and have the same appraised
 by three suitable disinterested persons, and also if required by the court, an
 inventory of the real estate of the deceased. Second. Shall administer according
 to law and to the Will of the Testator all his goods, chattels, rights and credits,
 and the proceeds of all his real estate that may be sold for the payment of his
 debts or legacies, which shall at any time come to their possession, or to the
 possession of any other person for them and Third. Shall render upon oath,
 a just and true account of their administration within eight months,
 and at any other times when required by the Court or the law. And we do
 hereby appoint the said Irving W. Metcalf, Wilbur V. Metcalf and Maynard W.
 Metcalf Executors of all and singular the said goods, chattels, rights and credits which
 were of the said E. H. Metcalf deceased. In testimony whereof, I have hereunto affixed
