This release is also intended as a complete satisfaction of the following judgments rendered November 23, 1864 in the District Court, sitting in and for the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, in the following cases: in cause #223, wherein David T. Mitchell was plaintiff, and Peter Van Houten was defendant, in foreclosure of the mortgage recorded in Book "D", at page 250, as described above; and in cause #224, wherein David T. Parker, a natural Kansas of the second part; witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One thousand dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, and mortgage to the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the county of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: The east half (1/2) of the south west quarter (1/4) of section No. fourteen (14) in Township No. Thirteen (13) of Range eighteen (18). And also the north seven and one-half (7 1/2) acres of the east half (1/2) of the north west quarter (1/4) of section No. Twenty three (23) in Township No. Thirteen (13) of Range No. eighteen (18) it being that portion of the east half of the north west quarter of section 23 Township 13, Range 18, lying north of the center of second street Town of Clinton, vacated, Now Lawrence & Emporia State road, with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein.
