This indenture made this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of April in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred between James S. Harrison and Lottie B. Harrison his wife of Wellsville in the county of Franklin and state of Kansas of the first part, and Cayat Bros. of the second part, witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of three hundred twenty three &  $\frac{87}{100}$  Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part their heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the county of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the south west corner of the north west quarter of section eighteen (18) Township fourteen (14) Range Twenty (20) East running thence east on the south line of said quarter section fifty (50) rods, thence north one hundred sixty (60) rods to the north line of said quarter section, thence west along said north line fifty (50) rods to the north west corner of said quarter section thence south along the west line of said quarter section one hundred sixty (60) rods to the place of beginning containing fifty acres with the appurtenances, and all the taxes, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said parties of the first part does hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seised of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all encumbrances. This grant is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of three hundred twenty three &  $\frac{87}{100}$  Dollars according to the terms of a certain coupon note this day executed by the said parties of the first part to the said party of the second part in three payments as follows One hundred twenty three &  $\frac{87}{100}$  Dollars in sixteen months
