This indenture, made this eighteenth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred, between J. M. Jones and his wife Jennina E. Jones of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and Betty Munk of Batavia, Kane Co. Illinois, of the second part, witnesses that the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows to-wit: Lots No. Two hundred and two (202), Two hundred and four (204), Two hundred and six (206), Two hundred and eight (208), Two hundred and Ten (210), Two hundred and Twelve (212), Two hundred and fourteen (214) in the north east quarter of block No. eleven (11) in that part of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, known as North Lawrence, according to a plat filed in the office of the Register of Deeds of Douglas County, Kansas, on the twentieth (20) day of May 1872, with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said J. M. Jones and Jennina E. Jones do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted and seized of a good and individual estate of inheritance, therein, free and clear of all incumbrances, and that they will warrant and defend the same against all claims whatsoever. This grant is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment
