

Deed of release.

Whereas, F. M. Raley of Douglas County, Kansas, by his contract dated the 23 day of Nov. A.D. 1891, and recorded in the Recorder's office in and for Douglas County, Kansas, in book Mob. 25 at pages 246 conveyed to Stark Bros. of Louisiana, Pike County, Mo. The property in said contract described to secure to said Stark Bros. the payment of eighty dollars and in said contract fully described and set forth; and whereas, the said F. M. Raley has fully paid and satisfied said indebtedness and is justly and legally entitled to a full release of the said contract. Now, therefore, Stark Bros. do hereby remise, release and quit claim unto the said F. M. Raley and his heirs, the property in said contract described as follows, to-wit: The south one-half $\frac{1}{2}$ of the east one-half $\frac{1}{2}$ of the north east quarter of section no. thirty (30), township fourteen (14) Range twenty one (21) containing forty acres more or less, to have and to hold the same, with all the appurtenances thereto belonging, free, clear and discharged from the encumbrances of the said contract.
