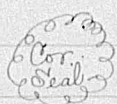


Whereas, John H. Andrews, holder and present legal owner of the promissory note secured thereby, by assignment in consideration of the premises and of the sum of one dollar, to us in hand paid before the delivery hereof, do hereby release all right, title and interest in or to the premises aforesaid in us vested by virtue of said Trust Deed.
