Knight his wife of Lawrence County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, part of the first part, and The Atlas Building and Loan Association of Lawrence, Kansas, party of the second part, Witnesseth, that the parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Three hundred dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the party of the second part, its successors and legal representatives, the following described real estate situated in the county of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit: Lots fifteen (15) and sixteen (16) in Block Fourteen (14) in Lane Place Addition, Lawrence Kansas. To have and to hold the same together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging.
