Head unmarried, of Lawrence County of Douglas, and State of Kansas part of the first part, and The Atlas Building and Loan Association of Lawrence, Kansas, party of the second part, Witnesseth, that the party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Eleven hundred Dollars, to him duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the party of the second part, its successors and legal representatives, the following described real estate situated in the county of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit: The south twenty first (75) feet of Lot six (6) Block Nine (9) in Babcocks Addition to Lawrence. To have and to hold the same together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging. The party of the first part, covenants and agrees that at the delivery hereof he is the lawful owner of said premises and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances, and will warrant and defend the same in the quiet and peaceable possession of the party of the second part its successors and legal representatives, forever.
