MORTGAGE Standard Form. SAM'L DODSWORTH BOOK CO., LEAVENWORTH, KAN.

This Indenture, Made this Twenty Six day of September, in the year of our Lord, nineteen

hundred and, between Henry Wilson and his wife Mary of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and Henry Glass and Bernard Neal of the same place of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said part us of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One hundred and Twenty five Dollars,

to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do — grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said part us of the second part their heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

Lot One hundred and fifty two (152)
except a strip eight (8) feet in width of the North side
received for bay Alley. And also all of Lot Number One
hundred and fifty four (154) Abin Block Number Fifty six
(56) in West Lawrence in the City of Lawrence according
to the Plat filed in the office of the Clerk of the District
Court of said Douglas County on the 24th day of September
1896

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said part us of the first part therein. And the said Henry Wilson and Mary B. Wilson parties of the first part do — hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances and that they will warrant and defend the title to the same against all persons lawfully claiming the same and they will pay all taxes and expenses in connection with the same, and they will keep the same in good repair and to be protected against damage from fire and lightning, and to be insured for a sum not less than \$1000 in some approved insurance company. This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of One hundred and twenty five dollars

according to the terms of three certain promissory notes this day executed and delivered by the said Henry Wilson and Mary B. Wilson to the said part us of the second part one for Forty dollars due in one year from date and one for Forty dollars due two years from date, and one for Forty five dollars due in three years from date all payable at the Merchants National Bank Lawrence, Kansas with eight percent interest commencing from date, and to be paid annually and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said part us of the second part their executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, and out of all the moneys arising from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale, on demand, to the said Henry Wilson his heirs and assigns.
