This Indenture, Made this 4<sup>th</sup> day of April in the year of our Lord, one thousand 1901  
 hundred and one, between Lester B. Cunningham and Gertrude M. Cunningham  
 husband and wife of Douglas in the County of  
Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and H. S. Patrick  
 of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of  
One hundred Dollars,

to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage  
 to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and  
 State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

All that portion of the north west quarter of section thirty four (34) township eleven (11) Range eight (8) lying east of the center of Coon Creek, except the right of way of the A. T. & S. F. Railway Co through same. Also Beginning at the north east corner of the south west quarter of section thirty four (34) said township and Range, thence west one hundred thirty (13) rods, thence south fifty one (51) rods, thence west forty seven (47) rods, thence south two hundred eighty (280) feet, thence east three hundred thirty one and one seventh (331 1/7) feet to the center of Coon Creek, thence up the center of said Coon Creek first in a southerly and then in a northeasterly direction to a point distant fifty one (51) rods south of the north line of said quarter section and ninety eight (98) rods west of the east line of said north west quarter of said section thirty four (34) township and Range aforesaid; thence east ninety eight (98) rods to the east line of said quarter section distant fifty one (51) rods south of the place of beginning; thence north fifty one (51) rods to the place of beginning.

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said  
Lester B. Cunningham do hereby covenant and agree that  
 at the delivery hereof he is the lawful owner of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible  
 estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances except a prior mortgage to said H. S. Patrick for \$2000.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of  
One hundred dollars  
 according to the terms of ten certain promissory notes this day executed  
 and delivered by the said Lester B. Cunningham and Gertrude M. Cunningham to the said party of the second part  
Each note for \$200 on the 4<sup>th</sup> days of October and April following until paid with interest after  
maturity at ten per cent per annum.

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale, on demand, to the said Lester B. Cunningham, his heirs and assigns.
