**MORTGAGE Standard Form.** SAM'l DODSWORTH BOOK CO., LEAVENWORTH, KAN.

This Indenture, Made this Third day of July, in the year of our Lord, one thousand Nineteen  
hundred and One, between J. C. Richardson and Celia Richardson, his wife, of Lawrence in the County of  
Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and  
Wm. J. Sinclair, of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, of the second part:  
**Witnesseth.** That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of  
Two hundred and fifty (\$250.00) Dollars,  
to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage  
to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and  
State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:  
Lot No. one hundred and seventeen (117) in Addition No. Three (3), North Lawrence,  
in the City of Lawrence.  
Said parties of the first part hereby agree to keep the buildings erected on said  
lot insured for at least \$200.00 during the existence of this loan.

*In consideration of the payment of the sum of \$250.00 in mortgage  
I hereby release the same to the said party of the second part  
on the 1st day of October 1905.

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said  
J. C. Richardson and Celia Richardson, his wife, do hereby covenant and agree that  
at the delivery thereof they are the lawful owner(s) of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible  
estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances and that they will warrant and defend  
the same in the quiet and peaceable possession of said second part, his  
heirs or assigns forever against all persons lawfully claiming the same. This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of  
Two hundred and fifty (\$250.00) Dollars,  
according to the terms of One certain Note this day executed  
and delivered by the said J. C. Richardson for part purchase money for above described property to the said party of the second part  
Due in five years from date, with interest from date to maturity as evidenced by coupons  
attached thereto and interest after maturity or default at the rate of 6% per annum until  
fully paid in cash or by Sheriff's Deed.  
and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or  
interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become  
due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter  
to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales to retain  
the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be  
paid by the parties making such sale, on demand, to the said J. C. Richardson, his,  
heirs and assigns.
