MORTGAGE Standard Form. SAM'L DODSWORTH BOOK CO., LEAVENWORTH, KAN.

This Indenture, Made this Thirtieth day of September in the year of our Lord, one thousand Nineteen
hundred and One, between Josephine H. Lawrence and James Lawrence her
husband of the Township of Wakarusa, in the County of
Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and J. P. Blair
of the second part:

Witnesseth. That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
Twelve hundred **Dollars,**

to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage
 to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and
 State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit: Commencing at a point where the north line of fractional north
 west quarter of section seven (7) Township Thirteen (13) Range twenty (20) intersects the west line of
 Vermont street produced south from the City of Lawrence, thence south along said produced west line
 of Vermont street twenty (20) rods to north line of land conveyed to straw Jones, described in
 deed recorded in deed book 18 p 501, said county records, thence west twenty (20) rods along north
 line said Jones' tract, thence south twenty (20) rods along west line said Jones' tract, thence
 west twenty (20) rods, thence north twenty (20) rods parallel with said east line to the south line
 of a tract conveyed to the township of Wakarusa, described in deed Book 43 Page 237 said
 county records, thence east ten rods along south line of said last named tract, thence north
 twenty rods along the east line of said last named tract to the north line of said
 quarter section, thence east on said north line thirty (30) rods to the place of beginning,
 containing six and one fourth (6 1/4) acres more or less.

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said

parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that
 at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owner of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible
 estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of
Twelve hundred dollars
 according to the terms of One certain Mortgage note this day executed
 and delivered by the said parties of the first part to the said party of the second part

Payable five years after date with interest at 6% semi-annually according to coupons attached
 to said note & note, after maturity or default privilege reserved to pay to any multiple thereof on
 account principal money when any interest falls due. and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or
 interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become
 due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter
 to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales to retain
 the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be
 paid by the party of the first part, on demand, to the said parties of the first part, their
 heirs and assigns.
