MORTGAGE Standard Form. SAM'l DODSWORTH BOOK CO., LAWRENCE, KAN.

This Indenture, Made this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of November in the year of our Lord, one thousand Nine  
hundred and One, between Mariguita H. Simpson and William H. Simpson  
her husband, of Chicago in the County of  
Cook and State of Kansas, of the first part, and Mrs Mary F. Simpson, of Lawrence,  
Kansas of the second part:

**Witnesseth.** That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of  
Thirteen Hundred **Dollars,**

to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, ha re sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage  
 to the said part of the second part her heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and  
 State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the north east corner of lot number Twelve (12) in Blocknum-  
 ber Four (4) in Babcock's Addition to the city of Lawrence, thence running  
 west on the north line of said lot Twelve (12) and of lot One (1) of said  
 Block Four (4) two hundred and fifty (250) feet; thence north fifty (50)  
 feet; thence running east parallel with the north line of said lots  
 Eleven and One (11) two hundred and fifty (250) feet; thence south fifty  
 (50) feet to the place of beginning - said land forming the south half  
 of vacated Euclid Street lying north of said lots one and Twelve (1+12),  
 in said Block Four (4), Babcock's Addition to the City of Lawrence.

with ~~all~~ the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said  
Mariguita H. Simpson and William H. Simpson do hereby covenant and agree that  
 at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owner(s) of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible  
 estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances except the taxes for the year 1901 and any  
special payment and curbing tax against said land.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of  
Thirteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,300) payable in monthly  
installments at six percent interest per annum,  
 according to the terms of a certain mortgage note this day executed  
 and delivered by the said Mariguita H. Simpson and W. H. Simpson to the said part of the second part

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or  
 interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become  
 due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said part of the second part her executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter  
 to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, for payment of any incumbrance, or any amount due to the parties of the second part, or their executors, ad-  
ministrators, or assignees, at any time thereafter, in any manner prescribed by law, and out of all the moneys arising from such sales, to retain  
 the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be  
 paid by the part of making such sale, on demand, to the said Mariguita H. Simpson and William H. Simpson,  
 heirs and assigns.
