This Indenture, Made this 15th day of September in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and two, between George Hoedl and Caroline Hoedl, his wife,

of Johnson in the County of Johnson and State of Kansas, of the first part, and Alfred F. Durr, Administrator of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Four hundred and six and 75/100 Dollars,

to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Johnson and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

The north west quarter of the south west quarter of section 14 Township 13 Range 21, containing 80 acres, also the N. 30 acres of the south east quarter of the north west quarter (north of Captains Creek) in section 14, Township 13 Range 21. Also that tract or parcel of land situated in Douglas County Kansas, as follows, Commencing at the south east corner of the north east quarter of section 15 Township 13 Range 21, thence north 34 1/2° west 14 1/2 chains, thence N 3 1/4° west 5° chains thence N. 40 1/2° east 3° chains, thence N 60° east 2 1/2 chains, thence east on quarter section line 4 1/2 chains to section line, thence south on section line 80 rods, to place of beginning, containing eleven acres more or less.

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances except a first mortgage for \$1400 dated March 16, 1898.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Four hundred and six and 75/100 dollars according to the terms of one certain promissory note this day executed and delivered by the said George Hoedl and Caroline Hoedl to the said party of the second part

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale, on demand, to the said parties of the first part, their heirs and assigns.
