Date. This Indenture, made and executed this sixth day of November A.D. nineteen
Parties. hundred one by and between George J. Achle (widower) of the County
of Douglas, and State of Kansas, party of the first part, and The
Union Central Life Insurance Company, of Cincinnati, State of Ohio,
party of the second part: Witnesseth, that the said first party for and
in consideration of the sum of Eighteen hundred (\$1800) Dollars,
paid by the said second party, the receipt of which is hereby acknow-
ledged, mortgage and warrant unto the said second party, its success-
ors and assigns, forever, the certain tract or parcel of real estate,
situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described
as follows, to-wit: The south east quarter of section Thirty four (34),
Township Fourteen, (14), Range Eighteen (18), East of the Sixth Principal
Meridian, containing one hundred and sixty (160) acres, according to
Government Survey. To secure the payment of a debt evidenced by
certain promissory notes of even date herewith signed by George J. Achle
of said first party, and payable to the said second party more fully
described, as follows: One principal note for the sum of Eighteen
hundred dollars, (and being for the principal sum loaned,) payable
ten years after date (or in partial payments prior to maturity, in
accordance with the stipulation therein) with interest at the
rate therein specified and evidenced by coupon notes. The said
first party hereby covenant and agree with the said second party,
its successors and assigns, as follows: First. To pay all taxes,
assessments and charges of every character which are now,
or which hereafter may become liens on said real estate; also
all taxes assessed in Kansas against said second party, on
this mortgage or debt secured hereby, and to deliver to the said
second party at its office, in Cincinnati, Ohio, receipts of the proper
officer for the payment thereof; and if not paid, that the holder
of this mortgage may pay such taxes, liens or assessments,
(of which payment amount and validity thereof, the receipt
of the proper officer shall be conclusive evidence), and be entitled
to interest on the same at the rate of ten per cent. per annum,
and this mortgage shall stand as security therefor. Second.
To keep all buildings, fences and other improvements on said
real estate in as good repair and condition as the same are
in at this date, and shall permit no waste, and especially
no cutting of timber except for making and repairing of fences
on the place, and such as shall be necessary for firewood
for the use of the grantor's family. Third. - To keep, at the
option of said second party, the buildings on said premises
