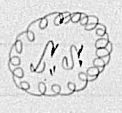

This Indenture, made this first day of January A.D. 1902 by and between
E. John Pittsford & Myra F. Pittsford his wife of Lawrence County of Douglas,
and State of Kansas, parties of the first part, and F. N. Bruner
party of the second part. Witnesseth: That the party of the first
part, in consideration of the sum of six hundred & fifty dollars,
to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, had
sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto
the party of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators or
assigns, the following described real estate situated in the county
of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit: Lot thirty four (34) New
York street in the city of Lawrence, Kansas. To have and to hold the
same together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments
and appurtenances thereto belonging. The parties of the first
part covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are
the lawful owners of said premises and seized of a good and
indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of
all incumbrances, and will warrant and defend the same
