This Indenture made this 28 day of February in the year of our  
 Lord, one thousand nine hundred and two, between John Black  
 and Lucretia Jane Black, husband and wife, of Millville in the County  
 of Franklin and State of Kansas, of the first part, and M. E. Armstrong  
 and Chas. A. Munger of the second part, Witnesseth, that the said parties  
 of the first part, in consideration of the sum of eleven hundred  
 eighty dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby  
 acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain,  
 sell and mortgage to the said parties of the second part their heirs  
 and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated  
 in the county of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as  
 follows, to-wit: The north half (1/2) of the northeast quarter  
 of section Twelve (12) Township Fifteen (15) Range Twenty (20) East,  
 containing 80 acres, more or less, with the appurtenances and all  
 the estate title and interest of the said parties of the first part  
 therein. And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant  
 and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners  
 of the premises above granted, and seised of a good and indefeasible  
 estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all encumbrances.  
 This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of  
 the sum of eleven hundred eighty \$180 Dollars, according to the  
 terms of certain promissory notes this day executed by the  
 said parties of the first part to the said parties of the second part.
