Merriam party of the second part: Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred and Thirty-seven & ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars, to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part; his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situate in the county of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit: The northwest quarter (1/4) of section Twenty-four (24) and the northeast quarter (1/4) of the southeast quarter (1/4) of section Twenty-three (23) all being in Township Twelve (12) Range Seventeen (17) East. To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, forever, free and clear of all incumbrances except one note of even date for \$2500, due Mch. 1st 1907. Provided, always, and these presents are upon this express condition, that whereas said parties of the first part have this day executed and delivered Fourteen certain promissory notes in writing to said party of the second part for the sum of \$31²⁵ (each), due on or before the first day of March and September in each year, for seven consecutive years with interest at ten per cent. per annum after maturity until
