This Indenture made this 25th day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and two, between Martin B. Browlee and his wife Sarah A. Browlee of the county of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and Ellen M. Leary of the second part, Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows, to-wit: - The south west fractional quarter of section Thirty, (30) Township Thirteen (13) Range Twenty (20) E. of 6th P.M. 149⁷² Acres. according to Government survey more or less, with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances, and that they will warrant and defend the same against all claims whatsoever. This grant is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Two Thousand dollars, due and payable in five years from date thereof, with interest thereon from date at six per cent per annum, according to the terms of our certain promissory
