This Indenture, made and executed this ninth day of September A.D. nineteen hundred two, by and between John L. Kramer and Arizona Kramer, husband and wife, of the county of Douglas, and State of Kansas, party of the first part, and The Union Central Life Insurance Company, of Cincinnati, State of Ohio, party of the second part.
