

remaining unpaid on said bond and Mortgage from the first day of July A.D. 1901 to the tenth day of February 1903 at the rate of six (6) per centum per annum, and to pay interest on the said sum of five thousand (5000) dollars from the tenth day of February 1903, until paid at the rate of five (5) per centum per annum payable semiannually on the first day of January and July in each and every year and to pay the said principal sum of five thousand (5000) dollars remaining unpaid on said bond and mortgage, on the tenth (10) day of February A.D. nineteen hundred and six 1906, both principal and interest payable at the office of the said Insurance Company in the City of Milwaukee in the State of Wisconsin; and the said Ellen Mary McLeudy and Peter A. McLeudy her husband hereby covenant and agree that said Mortgage shall continue and remain as security for the payment of said principal sum of five thousand (5000) dollars, remaining unpaid on said bond and mortgage, and interest as hereinbefore stated, from the said first day of July 1901 until paid; and in case of default in payment of any installment of principal or interest at maturity, the provisions of said bond and mortgage making the principal sum due at the option of said Insurance Company shall be in force (notice of such option being hereby expressly waived); and the said bond and mortgage and all the covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as modified by this agreement.
