This indenture made this 15th day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and two between O. C. Sizer being the same person as O. G. Sizer so named as grantee in a deed to him from Charles W. Wells and Wife recorded in book 42 page 441 records of said County of June 15th Sizer his wife of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Alex Lewis of the second part. Witnesses that the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Fifteen hundred Dollars to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows, to wit: East half of North west quarter of Section Four (4) Township Fourteen (14) Range Nineteen (19) East of the sixth P.M. containing 81 1/2 acres more or less, with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances, and that they will warrant and defend the same against all claims whatsoever. This grant is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Fifteen hundred Dollars, due and payable
