This Indenture, Made this twenty fifth day of March in the year of our
 Lord one thousand nine hundred and three between James H. Dean and
 his wife Mary D. Dean of Clinton Township, in the County of Douglas
 and State of Kansas, of the first part, and Mary V. Dean of the second part.
 Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, in consideration of
 the sum of One thousand seven hundred and fifty Dollars to them
 duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold,
 and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said
 party of the second part, her heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or
 parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas,
 described as follows, to wit:

The South West Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Number Twenty-eight (28) in
 Township Number Thirteen (13) South of Range Number Eighteen (18) East
 of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Kansas; Also the following tract of land
 to wit: Beginning in the center of the highway near said Dean's dwelling
 house known as the Lawrence and Emporia State road at a point
 where the west line of said Dean's Quarter Section (the same preempted
 by him) crosses said road, thence North by said west line of said
 Quarter Section about Fifty-eight and one fourth ($58\frac{1}{4}$) rods to a stake
 & stone eight and one fourth ($8\frac{1}{4}$) rods South of the North West corner of
 said Quarter Section; thence West by a line parallel to the South
 line of the Quarter Section pre-empted by Horatio Warner, Twenty (20)
 rods to a stake & stone, thence South by a line parallel to the line first
 mentioned about seventy four (74) rods to the center of said highway;
 thence Northeasterly by the center of said highway to the place of
 beginning, containing about Eight one fourth ($8\frac{1}{4}$) acre, less
 about six tenths of an acre described as follows to wit: Beginning
 in the center of the highway known as the Lawrence and Emporia
 State road at a point directly opposite the end of a stone wall fence
 now being erected by said Bailey. thence by the center of said highway
 Southwesterly about Twelve (12) rods, to the Southwesterly corner of
 land heretofore conveyed by said Bailey to said Dean. thence North
 by land heretofore owned by said Bailey about Eighteen (18) rods to a
 stake and stone at the end of a stone wall fence, thence by said stone
 wall fence Southeasterly about Fourteen (14) rods to the point begun at.
 Also the following described tract of land to wit: Begin at a
 stake at the South West corner of the North half of the South half
 of the North West Quarter of Section No Twenty-eight (28) in Town-
 ship No Thirteen (13) Range Eighteen (18) East of the 6th P.M. thence
 North $80\frac{3}{4}$ degrees East 33 chains to a stone in the Clinton Road;
 thence South $45\frac{3}{4}$ degrees East $44\frac{3}{4}$ chains to a stake thence $80\frac{3}{4}$
