

Release of Mortgage.

Whereas on the 15th day of December, 1890, J. Glead and Lucy Glead, his wife, of Lawrence, Kansas, the mortgagees, executed and delivered to Eleanor P. Manley, the Mortgagee, their certain mortgage deed, conveying the following tract of land to wit: Begin Three Hundred and Seventy (370) feet south of Northeast corner of Southeast quarter of Section Thirty (30) Township Twelve (12) South of Range Twenty (20) East of the Sixth Principal Meridian; thence South Seventy five (75) feet; thence west one Hundred and thirty two (132) feet to the middle of Mainet Street in North Lawrence; thence North Seventy five (75) feet; thence East One Hundred and thirty two (132) feet to beginning in Block Seven (7) in that part of the City of Lawrence, known as North Lawrence, except as much as covered by said Mainet Street.

And whereas satisfaction has been made for the aforesaid note and the same has been cancelled and surrendered.

And whereas said mortgagee, Eleanor P. Manley, died on the 15th day of January, 1903, and Letters Testamentary upon her estate have been issued to the undersigned, C. A. Parmelee, and whereas said estate has received the full satisfaction of the aforesaid indebtedness.

Now Therefore, the aforesaid mortgage which was filed for record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Douglas County, Kansas, on the 15th day of December, 1890, and was there duly recorded in Book 24 of Mortgages on Page 30, is hereby released and discharged, and the aforesaid Register of Deeds of said Douglas County, Kansas, is hereby empowered to enter said discharge and release upon the records of said County.
