

Know All Men by These Presents, That, Whereas, on the tenth day of January, 1903, Donald M. Duggan et al filed a certain Bill of Complaint in the United States Circuit Court for the District of Kansas against The Kansas Mutual Life Insurance Company, impleaded with John P. Davis et al, in which said cause Cyrus Deland, Jr., George E. Cole and William W. Hooper, were on the fifth day of February, 1903, appointed Receivers or Trustees of said The Kansas Mutual Life Insurance Company; and, Whereas, the said Receivers or Trustees acting under the authority of the said Court and in accordance with the Statute in such case made and provided, have made a contract with the Illinois Life Insurance Company, and have agreed to transfer and turn over to said Illinois Life Insurance Company all the assets of said The Kansas Mutual Life Insurance Company; and,

Whereas, on the 27th day of June, 1903, an order was entered in the above mentioned cause of Duggan et al vs. Davis et al, approving the said contract of reinsurance, and containing, among other things, the words and figures following, to wit: The said Trustees shall transfer and deliver to the said Illinois Life Insurance Company, all and singular the property, real, personal, and mixed, belonging to said The Kansas Mutual Life Insurance Company, and they are further directed to make and execute due and proper conveyances, of any every sort, that shall be necessary or proper in order to vest the legal title to said assets in the said Illinois Life Insurance Company, and to endorse, assign and otherwise set over, all notes, bonds, mortgages, accounts, bills receivable, and all other choses in action; and the officers of said The Kansas Mutual Life Insurance Company are hereby ordered and directed to join with said Trustees in any and all such conveyances and transfers, and to execute the same in the name of said Company;

Now Therefore, for value received, The Kansas Mutual Life Insurance Company, of Topeka, Kansas, and Cyrus Deland, Jr., George E. Cole and William W. Hooper, as Receivers or Trustees for said Company, do hereby assign, transfer, set over and convey unto the Illinois Life Insurance Company, of Chicago, Illinois, and its assigns Five certain mortgages on certain real property in Douglas County, Kansas, and given by the following mortgagors, and dated at the times and recorded on the dates and in the records of said County, as hereinafter respectively set forth, together with the notes, debts, and claims secured by the said mortgages, to wit:
