This Indenture, Made and executed this fifteenth day of September
 1903 by John R. South Unmarried of Nemaha County, Nebraska,
 party of the first part, and The Union Central Life Insurance
 Company, of Cincinnati, Ohio, party of the second part; Witnesseth,
 that the said first party, for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty
 Seven Hundred Fifty (\$3750) Dollars paid by the said second party,
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Mortgages and Warrants
 unto the said second party, its successors and assigns, for and for the
 certain tract or parcel of real estate, situated in Douglas County,
 Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: The South East quarter of
 section Eleven (11), West half of North East quarter section Fourteen
 (14) and the North half of the South West quarter of section Fourteen
 (14), all in Township Fourteen (14), Range Nineteen (19), East of the
 Sixth Principal Meridian, containing Three Hundred and Twenty
 (320) acres, more or less To Secure The Payment of a debt evidenced by
 certain promissory note of even date herewith signed by John R. South
 of said first party, and payable to the said second party, more full de-
 scribed, as follows: One principal note for the sum of Thirty Seven
 Hundred Fifty Dollars, (and bring for the principal sum loaned),
 payable ten years after date or in partial payments prior to maturity,
 in accordance with the stipulation therein with interest at the rate
 therein specified and evidenced by coupon notes.

The said first party hereby covenants and Agrees with the said second
 party, its successors and assigns, as follows:

First- To pay all taxes, assessments and charges of every character which
 are now, or which hereafter may become liens on said real estate, also all
 taxes assessed in Kansas against said second party, on this mortgage
 or debt secured hereby, and if not paid, that the holder of this
 mortgage may pay such taxes, liens or assessments, and be entitled
 to interest on the same at the rate of ten per cent. per annum
