

Whereas, on or about the ninth day of December A.D. 1898 Clara E. McIntire and Levi O. McIntire of the County of Douglas, in the State of Kansas, executed and delivered to The Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance Company, a corporation of the State of Wisconsin, their bond bearing date on that day, conditioned for the payment to the said Insurance Company, or to its certain assignee, successors or assigns, of the sum of two thousand (2000) dollars at the expiration of five (5) years from the date of the said bond, with the privilege of paying one hundred (100) dollars, or more, of said principal sum on any interest paying day after two (2) years from the date of the said bond and before maturity, with interest thereon, until paid, at the rate of six (6) per centum per annum, payable semi annually on the first day of January and of July in each and every year; and at the same time the said Clara E. McIntire and Levi O. McIntire, her husband, executed and delivered to the said Insurance Company a mortgage, bearing even date with said bond, upon certain real estate lying and being in the County of Douglas in the State of Kansas, and more particularly described in the said mortgage, as security for the payment of said bond, and which said mortgage was recorded in the Register of Deeds office of the said County of Douglas, in the State of Kansas, on the twenty second day of December A.D. 1898 at eight o'clock A.M., in volume 35 of Mortgages, on pages 212-4;

And Whereas, no part of the said principal sum of two thousand (2000) dollars has been paid to said Insurance Company on said bond and mortgage; And Whereas, the rate of interest on said bond and mortgage has been reduced to five (5) per centum per annum, and the interest has been paid to the first day of July 1903, and there remains unpaid on said bond and mortgage of the principal thereof, the just and full sum of two thousand (2000) Dollars with interest thereon from the first day of July 1903; And Whereas, the premises described in the aforesaid mortgage have been conveyed to one R. L. Johnston, subject to said mortgage which he assumed and agreed to pay; And Whereas the name of the said R. L. Johnston is Robert L. Johnston and his wife's name is Helene A. Johnston; And Whereas, the said Robert L. Johnston has requested the said Insurance Company to extend the time of payment of the said principal sum of two thousand (2000) dollars, remaining unpaid on said bond and mortgage, until the ninth day of December A.D. 1908, with the privilege of paying one hundred (100) dollars, or more, of said principal sum, on any interest paying day after the ninth day of December A.D. 1904, and before maturity, and the said Insurance Company has consented and agreed to make such extension as requested,
