

(5000) dollars remaining unpaid on said bond and mortgage, as follows, to wit: two hundred and fifty (250) dollars thereof on the fourth day of February A.D. nineteen hundred and six (1906); two hundred and fifty (250) dollars thereof on the fourth day of February A.D. nineteen hundred and seven (1907), and the remaining forty-five hundred (4500) dollars thereof on the fourth day of February A.D. nineteen hundred and nine (1909), with the privilege of paying one hundred (100) dollars or more, of the unmatured portion of said principal sum on any interest paying day after the fourth day of February A.D. nineteen hundred and five (1905) and before maturity both principal and interest payable at the office of the said Insurance Company in the city of Milwaukee, in the State of Wisconsin; and the said Susannah C. Gilmore and John Gilmore, hereby covenant and agree that said mortgage shall continue and remain as security for the payment of said principal sum of five thousand (5000) dollars, remaining unpaid on said bond and mortgage, and interest as hereinbefore stated, from the said first day of January 1904 until paid; and in case of default in payment of any installment of principal or interest at maturity, the provisions of said bond and mortgage making the principal sum due at the option of said Insurance Company shall be in force (notice of such option being hereby expressly waived); and the said bond and mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as modified by this agreement.
